## ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2018-19

New Horizon College constantly strives towards excellence. In order to uphold the quality, a few important initiatives taken during the year 2018-19 are highlighted

The Academic year 2018-19 began with Orientation day for the freshers.

The college enriches the teaching learning experience by organizing seminars, conferences and workshops. A host of such events were conducted this year. A Multi disciplinary International Conference 'ICON' was organized in October 2018 and released a book with 100 plus publications. A National level Workshop 'PYTHON' by Mr. Vineet Kumar G was conducted for the Department of Computer science on 24th September 2018. Our college in association with 'The National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development' conducted workshop on 'Entrepreneurship Empowerment and Skill Development' on 11th September 2018. In addition to this Seventy Guest Lectures were organized with high profile speakers, for the benefit of students of all streams of BCOM, BBA and BCA

This year our college registered with NPTEL and paved the way for acquiring additional knowledge. More than 40 students and teachers have registered and taken online certification course. As a green initiative Online examination system was introduced for subjects in multiple Choice questions (MCQ) format.

As an initiative to upgrade technical know-how a new digital lab has been set up with 19 systems of latest configurations. In addition to this a Business lab with 34 systems has also been developed.

To enhance Institutional social responsibility among the students, a fund raising activity called Aarohan and Summer Mela was organized. Students set up stalls and the amount collected was used to meet the needs of under privileged children. Our college is registered under UNNAT BHARAT ABYAN Scheme of the Government and we have adopted five villages. Our students will strive towards the progress of these villages and also learn social responsibility.

In an attempt to make students industry ready they have been motivated to pursue their Internships to develop extra skills and have practical exposure. As a result more than 130 students have successfully taken up internships. The college has also successfully provided placement for 145 students in reputed companies with rewarding packages.

For all round development of Students a number of cultural, extra-curricular and sports activities are conducted throughout the year. An Intercollegiate Table Tennis Championships for men and women and selection trials for Bangalore University was conducted in the college campus that provided good exposure for sports activities.

Mentioned here are highlights of the various activities conducted in addition to the regular activities. The attempt to give the best will continue to achieve our motto in pursuit of excellence.

The annual computer quiz was conducted by the department. The purpose of the quiz is to assess the knowledge acquired by the students. The quiz helped the students to gain information on various subjects.



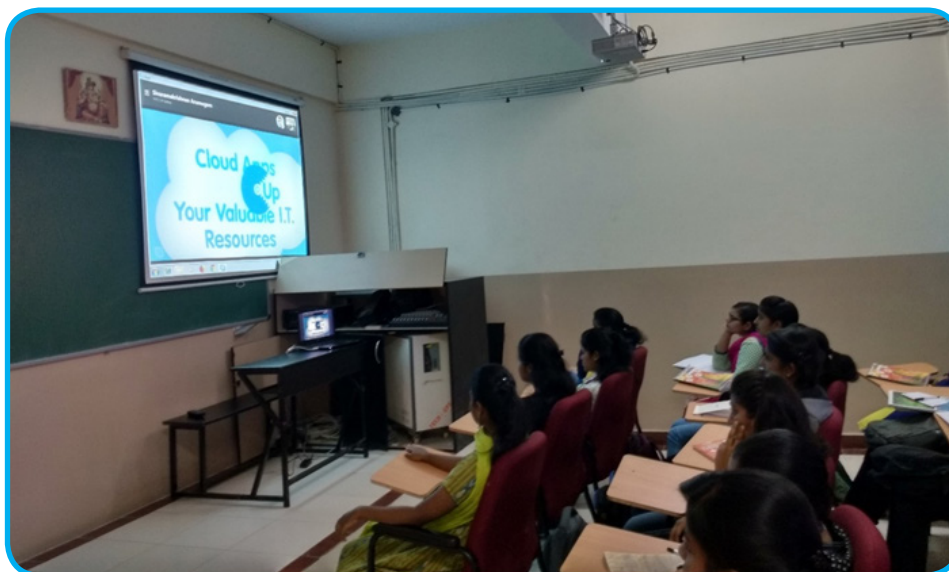
## TECHNOZARRE JUNIOR 2018 INTERCOLLEGIATE IT FEST GAMIFICATION

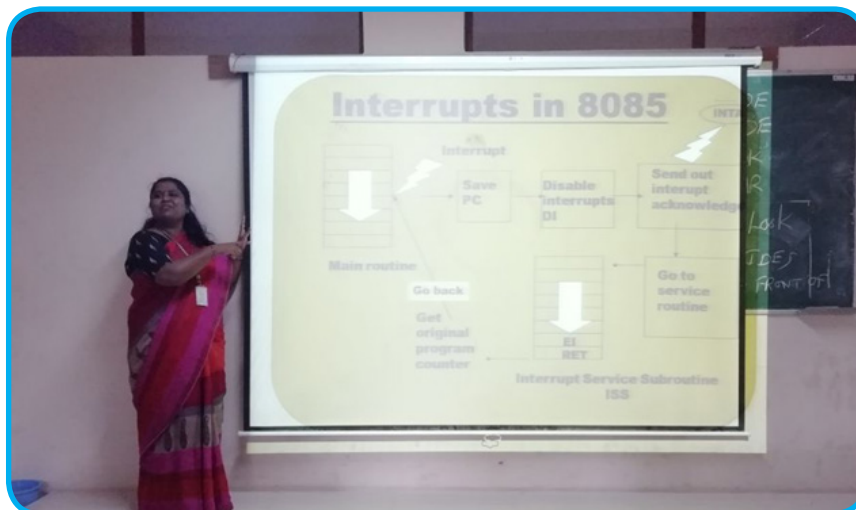


## “FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING”

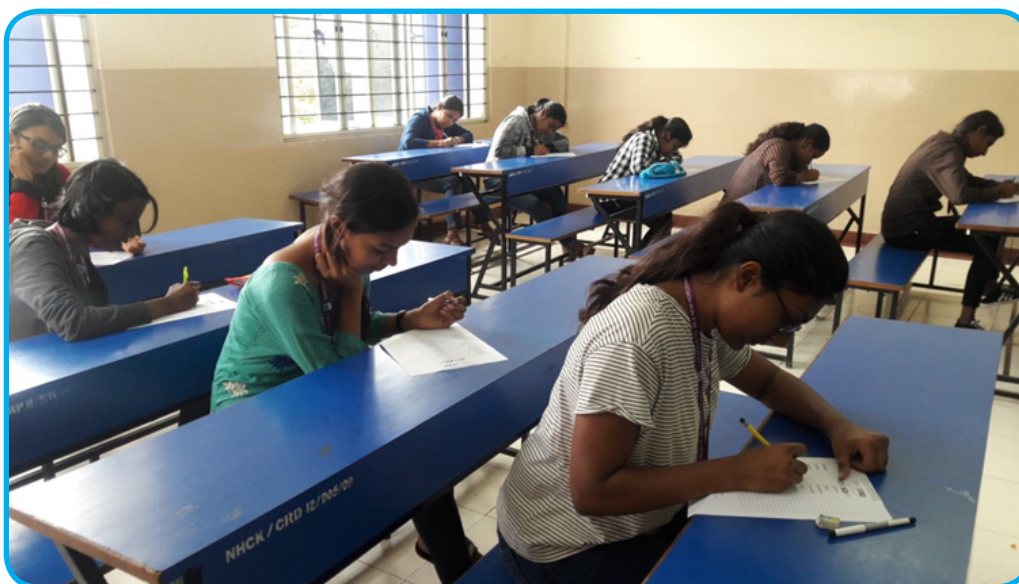
