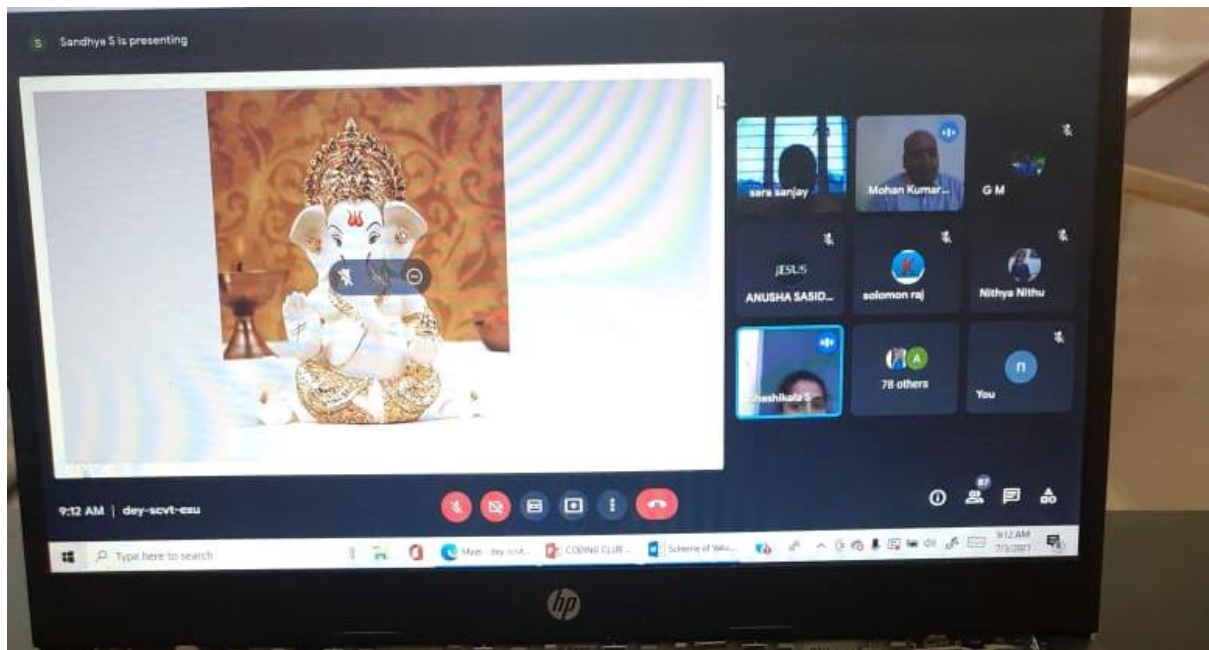
### **ABOUT THE EVENT**

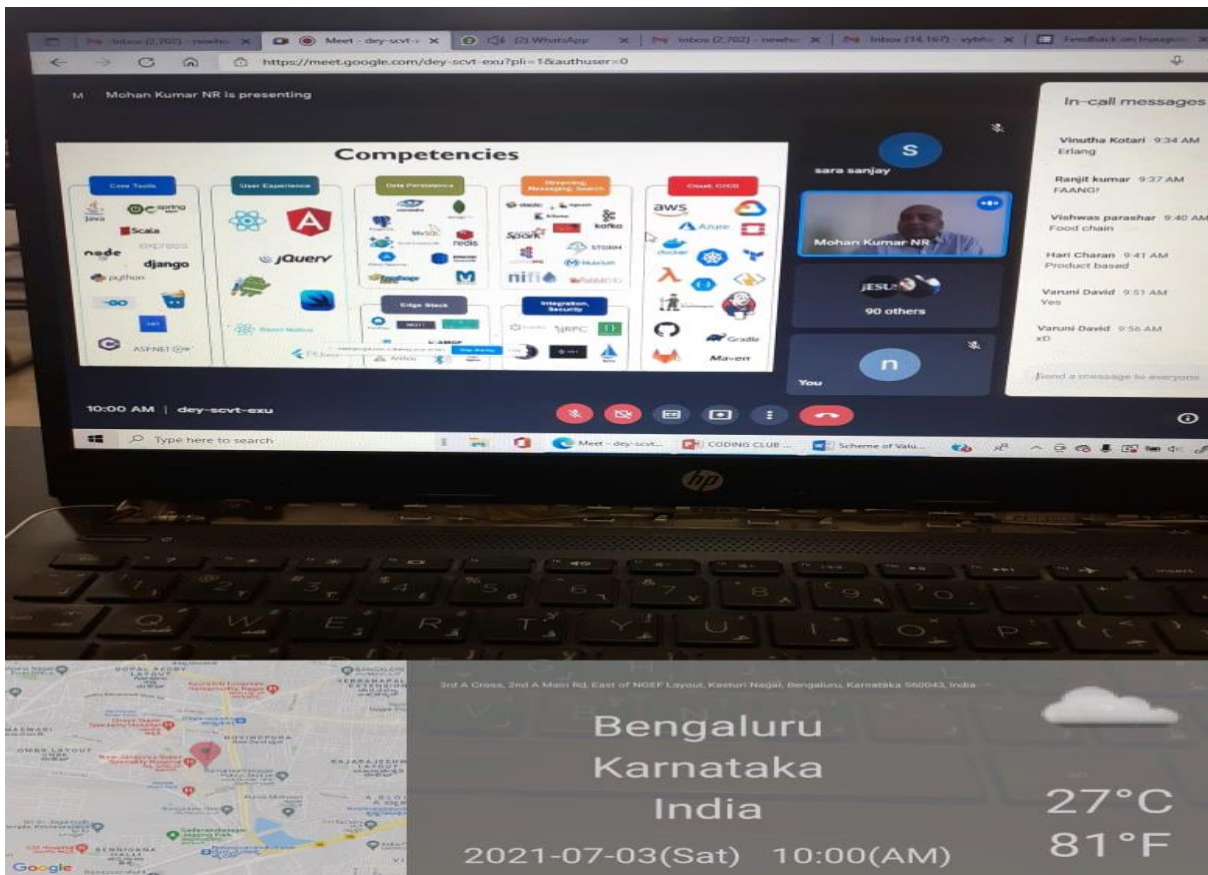

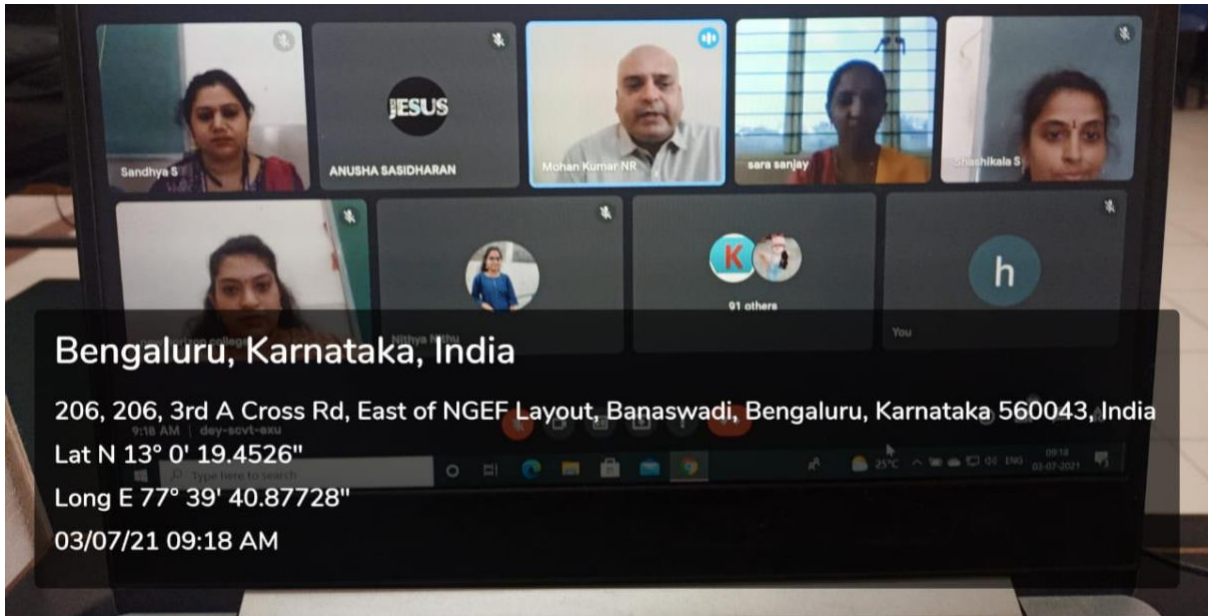
