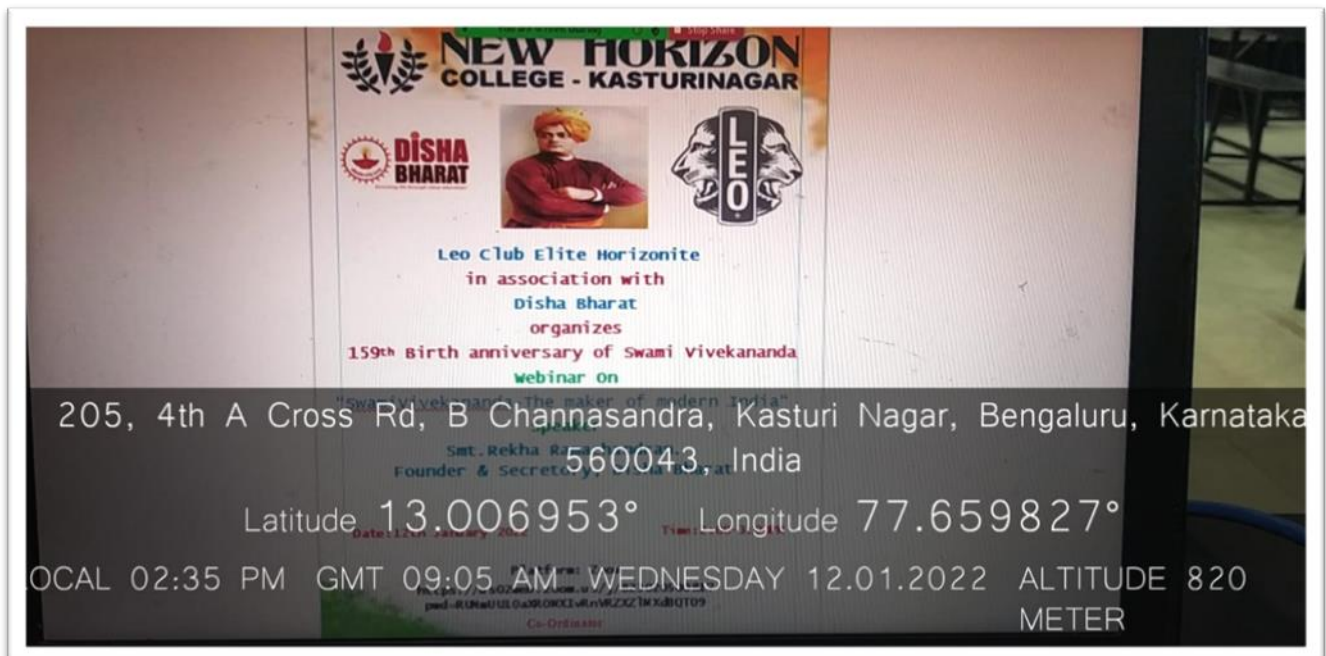

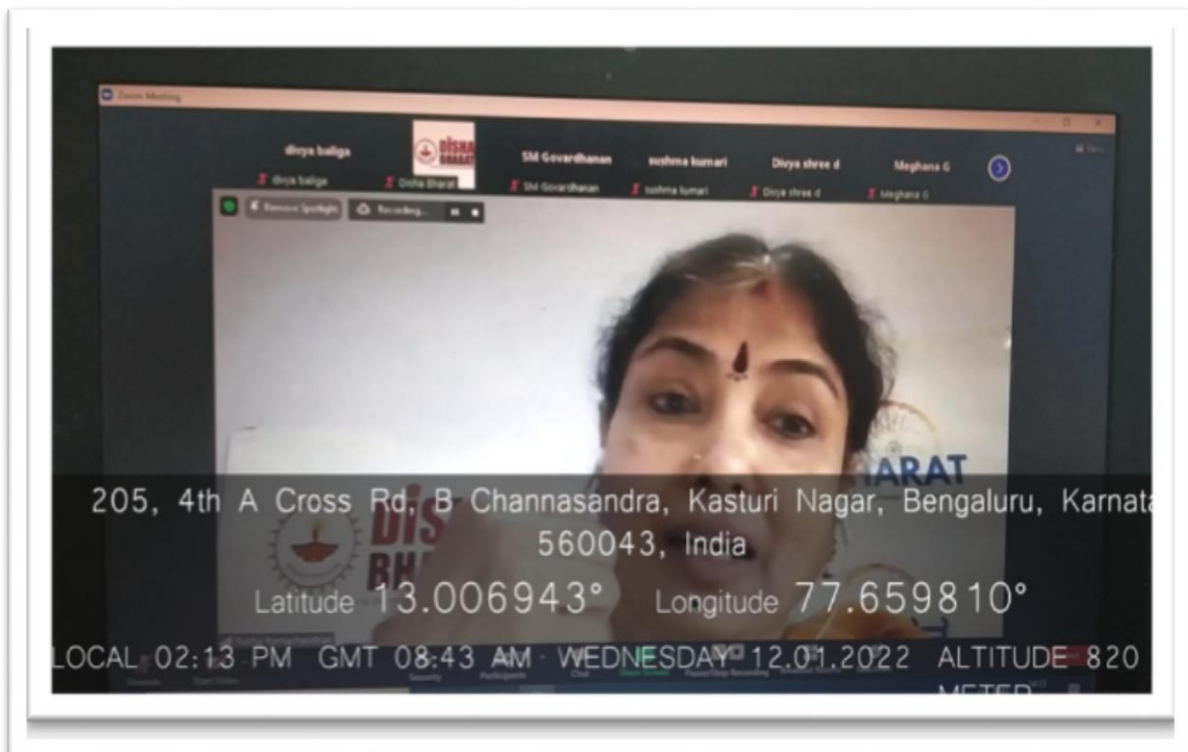
Objective:

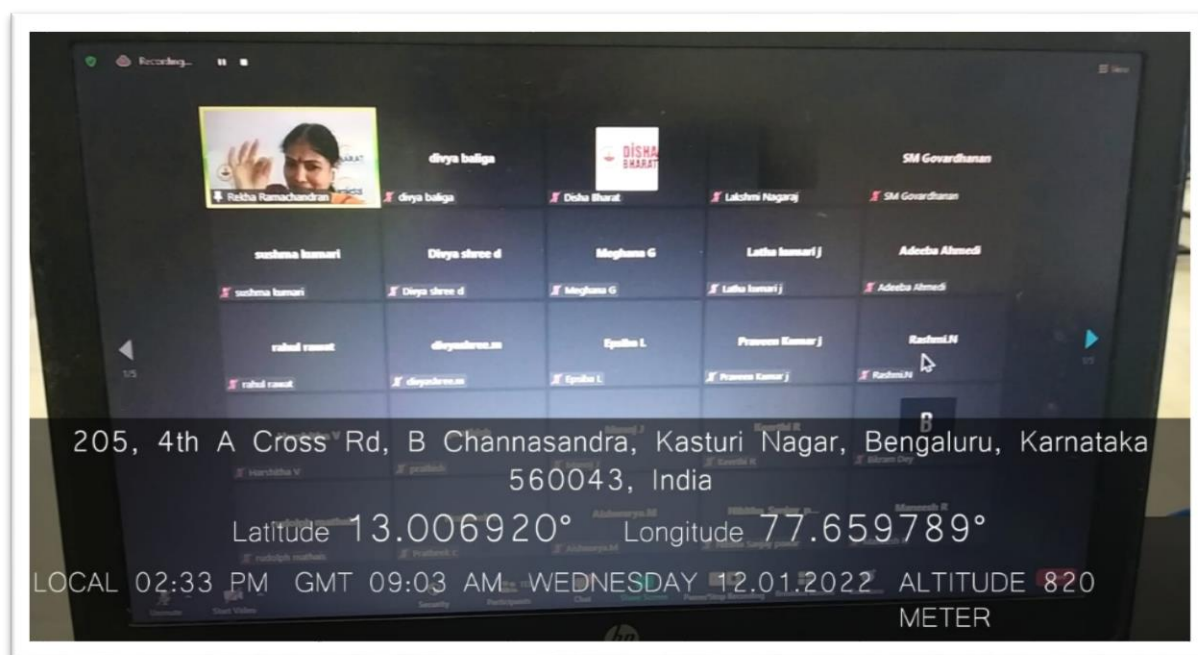

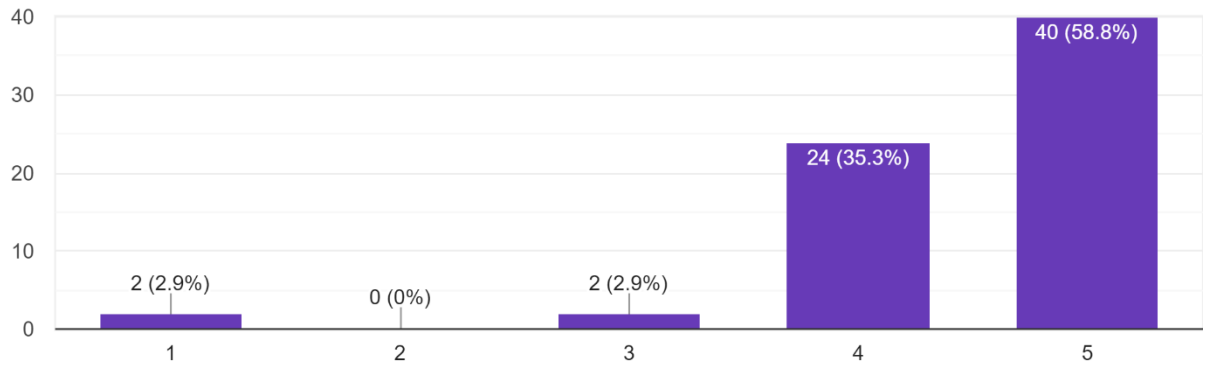

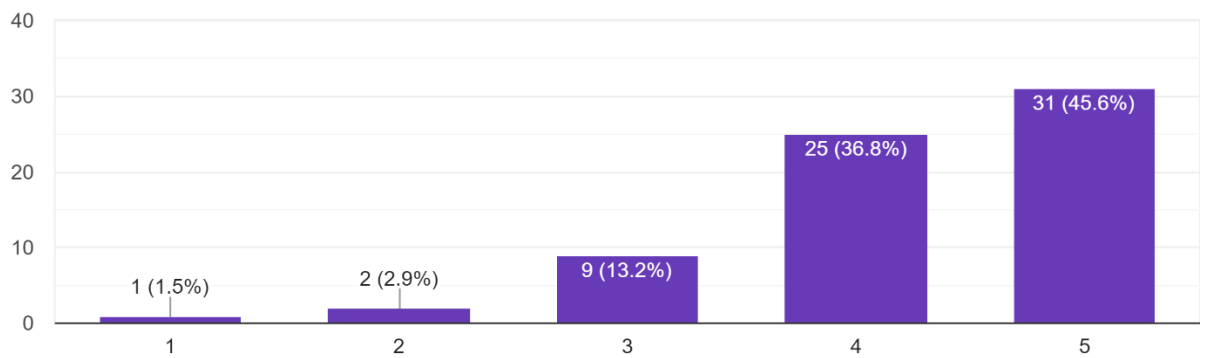
How do you rate the relevance of the session?

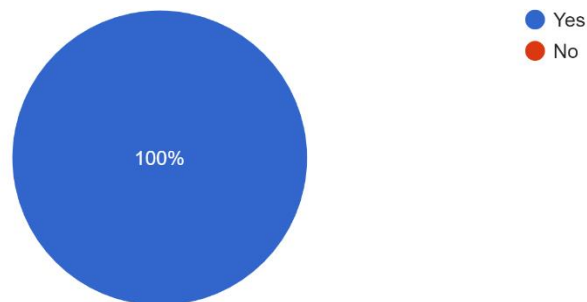
How do you rate the time management of the session?
